Master Degree Programs

KDI School's Master Degree programs are divided into full-time and part-time courses. Full-time students are able to complete their coursework by the end of the first year. They usually spend the second year working on their research component. The minimum time required for graduation is 1 year. Part-time programs use a flexible combination of evening and weekend classes, and students can graduate within two years without interrupting their careers. 


2017 Admitted Student Profile |










Ultra-modern facilities
